Dear Parents,

Woodland Hall Academy is proud to offer this unique educational opportunity for your child this summer. Since 1975, our program has been assisting children to develop academic skills and make gains which have allowed them to become achievers.

This summer, June 26 through July 21, 2017 (off July 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>), your child will receive the most intensive, individualized instruction in Tallahassee. During the summer session, each student has 36 instructional sessions of one-to-one reading tutoring and 18 instructional sessions of small group (5:1) study strategies and language arts instruction. The quality and amount of instruction for the cost, approximately \$18.00 per class, is unsurpassed by other programs in Tallahassee.

Optional computer and art classes are available for an additional fee.

In order to enroll your child into our Summer Program, the following steps must be taken:

- 1) **Currently Enrolled Woodland Hall Students:** A non-refundable Registration/Screening Fee of \$100 is required.
- 2) **New Students:** A \$150 Registration/Screening Fee is required to schedule a screening. Should Woodland Hall Academy determine through the screening that the program will not be suitable for your child, the \$50 Registration Fee will be returned. Otherwise, the Registration Fee is non-refundable.
- 3) Completed application on file in the Business Office.
- 4) Signed Rules and Regulations on file in Business Office.
- 5) Signed Medical Release on file in Business Office.
- 6) Total fees paid on or before June 1, 2017. There will be no refund of tuition after June 10, 2017.
- 7) Tuition for the Summer program is \$960 (approximately \$18.00 per class).

The following is some basic information regarding the 2017 summer program:

**TIMES:** Write in the time your child will be at WHA. \_\_\_\_\_

**DRESS:** Shirts/Blouses - Any color; with collars; no writing, pictures, or drawings.  
Slacks/Skirts - Any color; no jeans, or miniskirts. If pants have belts loops, belts must be worn.  
Dresses - Any color dress, no mini or backless dresses.  
Shorts - Permitted for ages 11 and under; any color; must be hemmed; no cutoffs, jeans shorts, short shorts or gym shorts.  
Shoes - Leather shoes, sandals with backstrap, clean tennis/jogging shoes. "Crocs" type shoes and "toe" shoes are not allowed.  
Hair - All student's hair should be clean and well groomed and of a natural color with boys' hair off shirt collar and not past bottom of ear lobe.  
Accessories - Students must leave cell phones in the office while at school. Boy's may not wear earrings. Visible body piercings are not permitted. The school reserves the right to ascertain acceptability of any single article of clothing or accessory.

**SNACK:** Students will have a 10 minute break where they may eat one item with 3 grams or less of sugar.

**AFTER SCHOOL DISCIPLINE:** Occasionally a student will need to stay after school to complete work or to take care of a behavior problem. We will make every attempt to contact the car pool before school is over. We do try to take care of a problem on the day that it happens. We will discuss the problems with the parents to determine if further action is needed.
